What to pack for camp:

- Sleeping bag or fitted twin sheet w/blanket
- Pillow
- Clothing for all weather (pants/shorts/shirts/jacket or sweatshirt)
- Towels (shower and beach)
- Shoes and sandals
- Swimsuit (girls: one piece or dark shirt over a 2 piece)
- Toiletries (toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, deodorant, shampoo, hygiene supplies, etc)
- Sunscreen
- Refillable water bottle
- Spending money (suggested \$5 -\$10 per day) for snacks, etc. *Café does accept credit cards
- Flashlight
- Bible and pen for taking notes (we will provide a journal)

Optional items:

- Small bag or backpack
- Shareable snacks
- Earplugs
- Bug Repellant

What NOT to pack for camp:

- Cell phone
- Electronics (no ipads, laptops, video game devices, mp3 players, etc)
- Valuables (jewelry, watches, etc)
- Weapons (including guns, small knives, pocket knives, lasers)
- Any type of alcohol, tobacco, or drugs

Please note: All personal property is brought at campers own risk. Camp and church staff will not be responsible for any items lost or left at camp.

MLCC YOUTH MINISTRY CAMP CODE OF CONDUCT AND EXPECTATIONS

Please read through all statements thoroughly. All rules must be followed or dismissal from Camp may result. MLCC Youth Leaders reserve the right to ask anyone to leave that does not comply with these rules and/or endangers the safety of anyone present at Camp without compensation for tuition or any other costs that student has incurred.

- 1. Those identified as Leaders for Camp are in charge of maintaining and keeping everyone safe. Every decision they make will be in the best interest of the overall camp experience. Therefore, any request made by a Leader must be followed immediately.
- 2. Cabins will be assigned separately for boys and girls. Students will have Leaders in each cabin and will be expected to obey any cabin rules given to them by their Leaders.
- 3. At no point in time will boys be allowed in the girls cabins or bathrooms. At no point in time will girls be allowed in the boys cabins or bathrooms. At no point in time will a girl and a boy be allowed to be alone at any point during camp.
- 4. Cell phones and Electronics (ipads, laptops, video game devices, mp3 players, etc) are not allowed at Camp. If a Cell Phone must be brought it will be stored with a Leader during Camp and given back after Camp ends. MLCC Leaders are not responsible for lost or damaged cell phones or electronics.
- 5. We are guests at Silver Lake Camp and we want to respect their rules and property. Intentionally damaging Silver Lake Camp in any form will not be tolerated. We understand that accidents may happen and expect any accident resulting in damage to Silver Lake Camp to be reported immediately.
- 6. Once you are at Camp you are expected to stay at Camp until Camp has ended.
- 7. A MLCC Youth Leader reserves the right to call a guardian to come pick up a student before camp ends in the event they determine the student is not abiding by the Code of Conduct. If the guardian is unable to pick up their student the guardian agrees to pay all costs associated with transporting that student back home. If a student chooses to leave camp for any reason a guardian must come pick up their student. If the guardian is unable to pick up their student agrees to pay all costs associated with transporting that student back home. - 8. Absolutely no alcohol, tobacco, drugs of any kind (legal or illegal), fireworks, or weapons of any kind are allowed during camp. All bags will be searched upon check-in for Camp. If any of these items are found, it will be cause for immediate dismissal from Camp without compensation for tuition or any other costs that student has incurred.
- 9. Everyone is expected to behave in a way that is respectful to themselves and others during Camp. We are partnering with other churches for Camp and we want to be invited back each year.
- 10. Camp check-in will be at 2:30pm SHARP on June 23 at MLCC. If a student does not arrive on time for check-in to be completed before we leave they will need to find alternative transportation at their own cost. If a guardian is not present during the scheduled pick-up time on June 27 the guardian agrees to pay all costs associated with transporting that student back home.

Logistics

Drop Off:

Please make sure you and your student arrive at Moses Lake Christian Church by 2:30pm SHARP on June 23, 2022. Please come in with your student so we can verify we have everything we need in order for your student to go to camp. Each student will need to have the following to be fully checked in and ready for camp.

- 1. A legal guardian with them.
- 2. Bags checked by one of our leaders.
- 3. Camp tuition paid in full.
- 4. A completed MLCC Medical/Permission & Release Form

Please Note: If a student does not arrive on time to be checked in before we leave for camp they will need to find alternative transportation to camp.

Pick Up:

Camp closes on June 27th at 10:30am. Our plan is to be back at Church by 12:30pm. Please plan to be at church to pick up your student no later than 12:15pm on June 27th. If for some reason we will be arriving later than expected you will be notified via text message. Our leaders are amazing and they will do everything they can to make this a great experience for your student so please make sure you help them out by arriving on time to pick up your student.
