




Connect the dots to discover a constellation!


- 1. God keeps his promises.

- 3. "For all of God's promises have been fulfilled in Christ with a resounding 'Yes!' " (2 Corinthians 1:20).


Stars in Your Eyes

EPIPHANY

We shepherds had one of the most special epiphanies of all time: We got to see Jesus right after he was born. We were some of Jesus' very first friends. Wow!

Many people celebrate a holiday called Epiphany in the first week of January, right after Christmas. It's a day to remember the time God came to earth as a human. Celebrating the birth of Jesus can be a special time of epiphany for you, too, as you look for God in your own life. It's like bringing light to the darkness.

Imagine what it would have been like if you had been one of us shepherds at the manger or one of the wise men bringing gifts to little Jesus.
